Dwarf Black Olive, Bucida Spinosa Care Sheet

DESCRIPTION

Spiny Black Olive, Dwarf black olive

Though commonly called "black olive" this tree does not produce an edible olive, but rather a small seed pod. Native to the Caribbean and the Florida Keys this delicate tree grows into a bonsai almost by itself! It is a evergreen tree, with a smooth gray – brown trunk, and small compact foliage. It is also very salt tolerant.

Lighting:

Though it can be grown indoors with some success, it does best outdoors in full sun.

Temperature:

Do not expose to temperatures below freezing, bring indoors or cover if 40 degrees or below is forecasted.

Watering:

Bucida Spinosa like to be well watered, do not allow them to get to dry. Tends to drop leaves if dry for to long.

Fertilizer:

We use a 6 month time release, 18-6-8. Miracle grow or similar water soluble fertilizer can also be used.

Pruning / Wiring:

This plant's natural growth pattern makes it ideal for bonsai. It will naturally change direction at each internode, making a bend of 25 to 35 degrees. Grows well with "clip and grow" methods. Also takes wiring well, branches tend to stay pliable up to a certain point. To achieve better taper in a young plant wire a horizontal branch upwards. Remove your old trunk/apex. Next wire all the auxiliary braches and rotate them to correctly level them with your new design.

Repotting:

Repot in warmer months – July through September. Nigh time temperatures consistently mid to high 70's. Use a well draining granular mix for good results.

Pests:

No pests or diseases are of major concern. We have never had a pest problem on our nursery plants.
